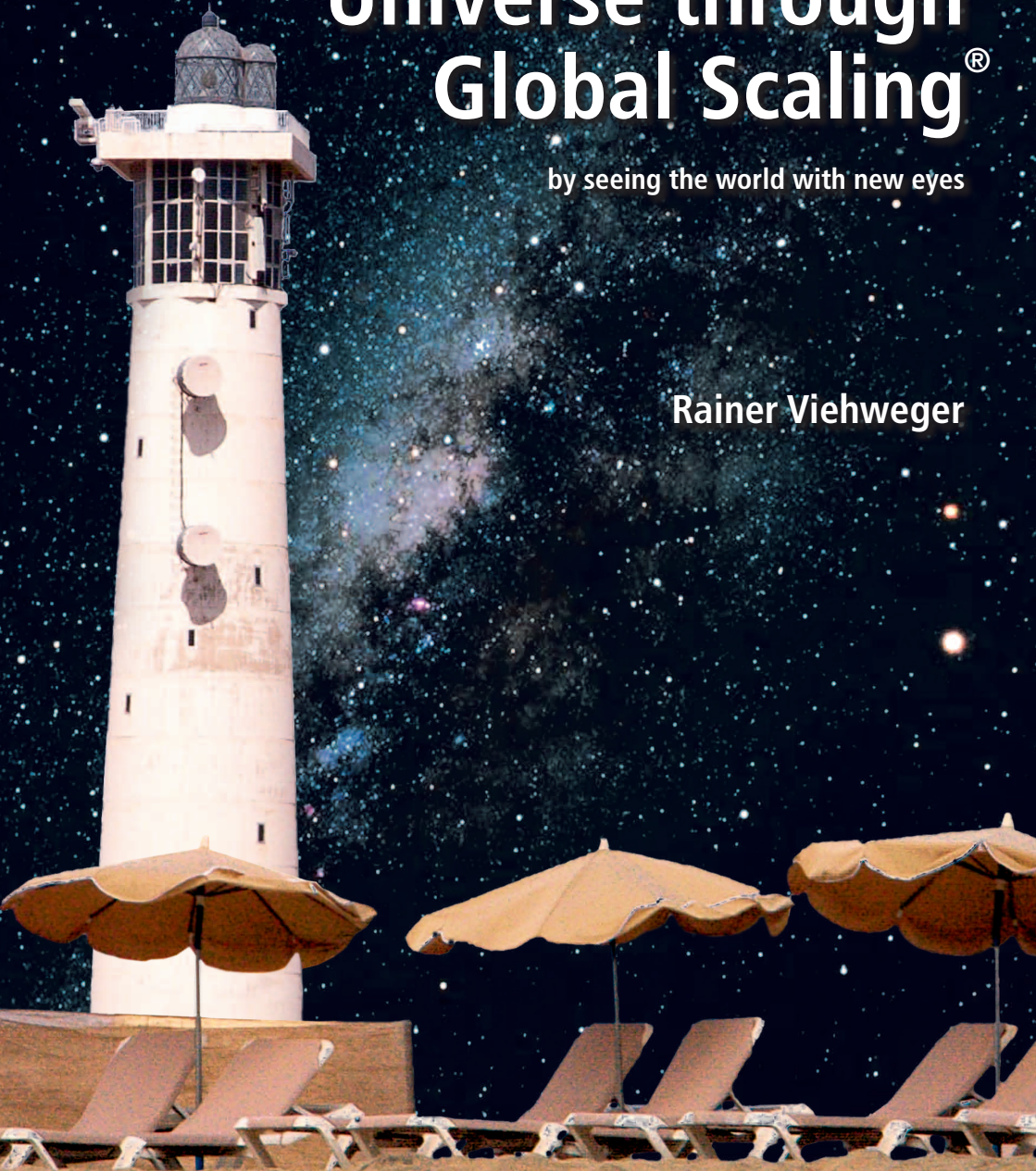


Understanding the Universe through Global Scaling[®]
